



**St. Pompilio M. Pirrotti, Sch.P. (1710-1766)**  
**A Collection of His Letters**

St. Pompilio M. Pirrotti is an 18<sup>th</sup> century Piarist, who worked in Naples, Italy. Pope Pius XI canonized him as a saint on March 19, 1934. His feast day is July 15. He was the second member of the Piarist Fathers, who was recognized as a canonized saint.

He wrote more than a thousand letters throughout his life. On the occasion of the 300<sup>th</sup> anniversary of his birth, the Piarists created a web page, which contains his writings. The letters on the site are in the original Italian. At the present time, they are also translated into Castilian (Spanish), Catalan and Polish.
